Send your Holy Spirit upon us and enliven us to share the Gospel. Break open our hearts with your Word and give us strength and wisdom to build up your Kingdom. Open our eyes to see your glory all around us, so that with shouts of joy we forever sing your praises. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Sunday, May 13-Good News



**Today's Readings:** *Acts 1:1–11; Psalm 47:2–3, 6–7, 8–9; Ephesians 1:17–23 or Ephesians 4:1–7, 11–13; 10:19–23; Mark 16:15–20.* In the First Reading, before ascending into heaven, Jesus promises the Advocate to his disciples. Even now, it is the Holy Spirit working within us so that we may live a holy life and proclaim the Good News to the ends of the earth. The Spirit rouses us from our slumber and stirs joy in our hearts; the Spirit urges us to share the Good News. When have you felt roused by the Holy Spirit? How did you respond?

In Baptism, we truly were given a great mission. As the Gospel says, it is a mission to proclaim salvation to every creature. For this mission, we need to rely on the sevenfold gift of the Holy Spirit, which strengthen us for our witness to **God's love. Each member of the Church has a set of gifts that, when united to the whole Body of Christ, assists the Church in building up the Kingdom. If we truly believe that Jesus is the Christ, then it makes good sense that we, God's chosen people, would shout with joy and clap our hands as our hearts burst with the greatest mystery to come to earth. In reflecting on Christ's reign in heaven, think about ways you might help others see God's glory and might. This week reflect on your gifts and talents and on how they can help in spreading the Good News.**

This Week at Home

Monday, May 14-St. Matthias

The First Reading tells the story of how Matthias joined the ranks of the Twelve. In the days following the Ascension, the Apostles decided to fill the place Judas had taken. Like Matthias, each of us has been chosen by the Holy Spirit to be followers of Christ. We are counted **among the saints who make known God's salvation. Have you ever taken time to consider your role as a disciple?** **Today's Readings:** *Acts 1:15–17, 20–26; Psalm 113:1–2, 3–4, 5–6, 7–8; John 15:9–17.*

Tuesday, May 15-Glorify the Lord

**Today's Gospel is part of a long prayer Jesus makes to the Father. Jesus is aware that the time has come for him to be glorified.**

Throughout his ministry, he has been preparing the disciples to know and understand that he is the one who saves. To have eternal life, we must come to know the living God. In Baptism, we were united to the living God and through our work we give him glory. In your prayer today, ponder what it means to be a temple of the Holy Spirit. **Today's Readings:** *Acts 20:17–27; Psalm 68:10–11, 20–21; John 17:1–11a.*

Wednesday, May 16-Teaching

Paul preaches to the presbyters of Ephesus in the First Reading. He tells them to be vigilant when he leaves because false teachers will surely pervert the Gospel message. Even today, we have false prophets among us and we must be vigilant that the Gospel is heard. Sometimes we might be the false teacher and so we too must be careful not to lead others astray. How have you shepherded another's faith? **Today's Readings:** *Acts 20:28–38; Psalm 68:29–30, 33–35a, 35bc–36ab; John 17:11b–19.*

Thursday, May 17-United in Christ

**Today's Gospel continues Jesus' long prayer in chapter 17 of John's account. When read completely through, the reader gets a sense of how much Jesus cares for his people. He truly longs for the day when all will know him and be united to the Father. As you think about this Easter season, how have you grown in relationship with Christ? Like Paul, we must take courage as we bear witness within our families and communities.** **Today's Readings:** *Acts 22:30; 23:6–11; Psalm 16:1–2a and 5, 7–8, 9–10, 11; John 17:20–26.*

Friday, May 18-Feed My Lambs

In the Gospel, Jesus questions Peter three times about how much he loves him. Peter responds affirmatively and assures Jesus of his love. **Like Peter, we are called to nourish God's flock. Each of us has been given gifts and talents that will help with this mission. What gifts do you bring to assist in "feeding the lambs"? Imagine yourself in Peter's place. How would you engage Jesus?** **Today's Readings:** *Acts 25:13b–21; Psalm 103:1–2, 11–12, 19–20ab; John 21:15–19.*

Saturday, May 19-So Much

**"There are also many other things that Jesus did." This line from the end of today's Gospel is telling. It relates that there is much about Jesus' life and ministry that we do not know. It also notes that the story of salvation is still unfolding. Let us rejoice in God's awesome gifts. Write about or draw a story of your encounter with Christ.** **Today's Readings:** *Acts 28:16–20, 30–31; Psalm 11:4, 5 and 7; John 21:20–25.*

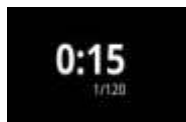
