If I have not, I ask for your forgiveness.

Please keep in touch! I know we will see each other again, but let us stay united in prayer until then. Don't forget to pray for me. I will always cherish Sacred Heart as my first priestly home. Thank you for everything. And so until we meet again, my God hold you in the palm of His hand. God bless.

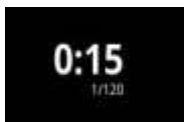
