The past two weeks at SHGS have been productive and full of learning. The very cold temperatures of the last week of January could not keep the halls of our school from being warm with energy and love, in part due to our Catholic Schools Week celebration. Throughout the week, students gathered change for the third grade's annual Pennies for People Project to benefit Sojourners Shelter for Women and Families. Pennies for People raised \$1246.64 this year! Grades 1-5 participated in a Living Rosary sponsored by our 4th graders. Younger students gathered dozens items to help the KCHA Animal Shelter, and older students collected toiletry items and canned food for Covenant House. On our Day of Giving, students gave their time by sorting donation items and participating in share time with partner classrooms. Our 4th & 5th grade choir members gave of their talents by singing to residents of Edgewood Summit. SHGS families gave of their treasure by raising \$26,330.00 on our Day of Giving. These donations go directly to the school's Funding Our Future Campaign for technological upgrades and capitol improvements. Students, faculty, and staff also enjoyed a Sock Hop during the week and gathered over 900 pairs of socks to donate to Sojourners Shelter as part of a Wear a Pair/Share a Pair of crazy socks event. Throughout the week we offered special prayers of gratitude for the many members of the SHGS community. We are so grateful for the support our SHGS family receives. Witnessing our students in action throughout the week serving, learning, and praying was truly inspirational. We concluded our special celebration with an All Schools Mass and of course by singing our school song, Beacons of Hope.

## 2019-20 PARENT INFORMATION REGARDING TUITION ASSISTANCE

For the 28th consecutive year, the Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) is striving to keep Catholic school education affordable for Catholic families who desire it for their children but who may need some financial assistance to make that dream a reality. Thanks to the ongoing and genuine commitment of The Most Reverend William Lori to the Catholic schools in our Diocese, funds have, once again, been allocated for distribution to Catholic families in need of financial assistance.

Applying for TAP through FACTS is easy and affordable. You are encouraged to apply if your child is already enrolled or has been accepted by one of the Catholic schools in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston for the 2019-2020 school year.

- Who is eligible? Any Catholic student accepted for the 2019-2020 school year in any Diocesan Catholic school (PK thru grade 12) and who belongs to a parish included on the drop-down list as part of the on-line application is eligible. Determinations are based upon a family's degree of need relative to all other applicants.
- How do I apply? **Applications are made on-line. Go to [www.factsmgmt.com](http://www.factsmgmt.com), click on "Grant & Aid Assessment" and log in.** If you do not have Internet access, contact your school office for assistance.
- Cost? The application fee is \$30. The Diocese will pay \$15 and families pay the other \$15.
- Grants: Diocesan grants for Catholic families who have completed their applications and show financial need will receive **up to 50% of the child's tuition.**
- Phase I Deadline In order to receive notification in late May, applications (*including all required documentation and payment of the fee*) are to be received by **FACTS by April 30, 2019**. Phase I is intended for families with children currently enrolled or already accepted for the 2019-2020 school year in any Catholic school in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston.
- Phase II Deadline In order to receive notification in early September, all applications for 2019-2020 (including August 15, 2019 *all required documentation and payment of the fee*) MUST be RECEIVED by FACTS no later than August 15, 2019. **This is a firm deadline.** Phase II is intended for families new to the school or who have had a life-changing event (i.e. birth, death, loss of job, major illness). If an application was submitted during Phase I, please contact the school. *Please do NOT submit a second application.*

Note 1: No assistance will be available from the Diocese or from any school unless:

- an application is completed in full (ALL questions answered) and submitted
- all required documentation is provided, AND
- the family portion (\$15) of the application fee is paid by the deadline.

Note 2: ONLY ONE APPLICATION PER FAMILY should be submitted per school year. If you made an error or had a life event change, please do NOT submit a second application. Contact your principal and your application can be updated by FACTS. Questions? If you have questions, please contact the principal of your school.

Charleston Catholic High School is now accepting application from prospective students. The following are deadlines to consider:

Students currently enrolled in Catholic schools: completed application packets will be accepted now through Monday, February 26 (to be given first consideration; applications received after that date will go into the general pool).

Students currently enrolled in public schools: completed application packets will be accepted beginning Tuesday, February 27.

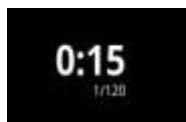
