Do you know someone who wants to become Catholic?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a “spiritual journey.” Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time (late August to Easter) suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful. The RCIA process is a restoration of the ancient catechumenate, arising within the first three centuries following the era of the apostles. It was the early Church’s way of Christianizing the pagan Roman Empire. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church.

From our music director...

A Joyful Psalm #60: Psalm 69

“Put yourself in someone else’s shoes.” Perhaps you have considered this adage within your lifetime. It can sometimes be difficult to imagine ourselves walking in the footsteps of someone else; living their very life-experience. The readings this weekend allow us to experience this very thing:

The Gospel Reading provides the famous parable of the Good Samaritan (Lk. 10:25-37). A man is beaten and left for dead. He is then rescued by a Samaritan man. Psalm 69 places us “in the shoes” of the beaten man: “I am afflicted and in pain; let your saving help, O God, protect me.” (Ps. 69:30) The psalm also places us “in the shoes” of the Good Samaritan: “See, you lowly ones, and be glad; you who seek God, may your hearts revive!” (Ps. 69:33)

Whether we are the victim of injustice or the faithful giver of charity, if we turn to the Lord in our need, we will live (eternally).
