Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

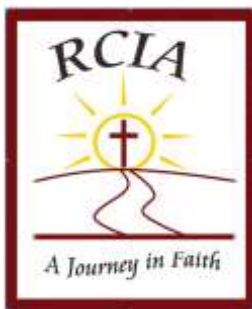
Greetings on this Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time!

### **Do you know someone who wants to become Catholic?**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a “spiritual journey.” Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time (late August to Easter) suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful. The RCIA process is a restoration of the ancient catechumenate, arising within the first three centuries following the era of the apostles. It was the early Church’s way of Christianizing the pagan Roman Empire. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church.

## **A Joyful Psalm #61: Psalm 15**

*I know you, I walked with you once upon a dream. I know you, that look in your eyes is so familiar a gleam.* Such are the words of Princess Aurora in the 1959 classic film, *Sleeping Beauty*. This timeless tale is a re-telling of the story of Christ, and it relates to our weekend readings:

The King and Queen have struggled to conceive a child for many years. Three fairies come to bless their newly conceived daughter, Aurora. The biblical parallel is from the First Reading this weekend: Abraham and Sarah are visited by three angels to announce the conception of their son, Isaac (Gen. 18:1-10).

Upon pricking her finger, the Princess Aurora is cast into a deep sleep – *Where, O death, is thy sting?* (1 Cor. 15:55). Prince Philip (Christ) is then given the Sword of Truth and the Shield of Virtue. He rides to the kingdom, only to discover that it has been surrounded by *a crown of thorns*. The Prince slays the dragon (Satan) and resurrects Aurora with a kiss. Christ is united with his Bride: The Church. The curse of death has been destroyed by the Son of the King.

By seeking the virtue of truth (like Abraham), and using it (like Princess Philip), perhaps we may slay the evils of Satan, and live in the presence of the Lord (Psalm 15).

**RE: Establishment of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Primary and secondary schools –an overview report**

As part of its vision, the Diocese of Chinhoyi prioritises integral human development notably through education. Having seen the acute shortage of learning facilities in and around Chinhoyi, the Diocese has made it part of its core objectives to construct new learning facilities for the disadvantaged communities of the Diocese.

In 2019, the Diocese acquired a piece of land (15hecares) for the construction of the first Catholic primary and secondary schools in the town of Chinhoyi which only has 15 schools of the required 25 schools for the ever growing population of the town. The Catholic Church in Zimbabwe has a very good name in education and riding on this reputation the Diocese sought to establish this school whose fee structure, while not completely out of touch with the ordinary parent, ensures that the schools has a healthy return to cater for day-to-day operating cost.

In 2020, the Diocese commenced the first phase of the construction of the primary school going by the name *Our Lady of Perpetual Help*. The first phase had the construction of two blocks consisting of four classrooms each, ablutions and computer rooms. Other notable works completed during the first phase include, fencing of both the school sites, sinking of four boreholes, electrical connections and the acquisition of school furniture. The first phase was successfully completed in December 2022. The school opened its doors in February 2022 and is now home to 200 children. The first phase was also supported by donors such as the Jesuit Mission Nuremburg in Germany, Misesan Cara in Ireland, RSHM sisters in USA and the Papal Foundation.

The Diocese is forever grateful for your kind support which has gone a long way in achieving the vision that the Diocese has.

The next phase of the project will be to construct two more classroom blocks at the primary school and also kick start construction of 12 classrooms at the secondary school.
