#### Do you know someone who wants to become Catholic?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process established for the universal Church for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a “spiritual journey.” Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period of time (late August to Easter) suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful. The RCIA process is a restoration of the ancient catechumenate, arising within the first three centuries following the era of the apostles. It was the early Church’s way of Christianizing the pagan Roman Empire. The Second Vatican Council called for the restoration and use of this venerable and powerful method of initiation for the worldwide Church.

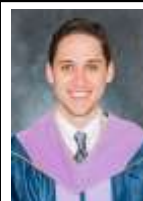

**From our music director...**

**A Joyful Psalm #60: Psalm 68**

The readings for this weekend are clear: *the least in society will be the greatest in heaven.*

Psalm 68 lists various downtrodden categories of people, and then demonstrates how God rights the wrong (Ps.68:6-7):

- to the orphans, God becomes father.
- to widows, God becomes their defender.
- to prisoners, God leads them to prosperity.
- to the forsaken, God provides a home.

Later, during the Gospel Reading, Jesus gives a parable about a wedding feast. A "wedding feast" is biblical imagery relating to heaven. Jesus heeds a warning: *those who seem to be the "least" in society, may be those seated first in the heavenly banquet.*

As we plow the field in this life, Jesus calls us to treat the "least" in society as we would treat Him. For then, "we will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous." (Lk. 14:14)
