A Joyful Psalm #69: Psalm 17

What will heaven be like? My kids sometimes ask about heaven: "Will there be go-karts" "Barbie Dreamhouses?" "Xbox?" They ask the question based on what they enjoy here on earth. There can be a danger in thinking that heaven will be like earth, but *just a little better*. In the Gospel Reading, Jesus describes heaven as something completely different than our life on earth: "Those who are deemed worthy to attain the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. They can no longer die, for they are like angels." (Lk. 20:34-36)

The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes heaven not as a place, but as a relationship: "Those who die in God's grace and friendship and are perfectly purified live for ever with Christ. They are like God for ever, for they 'see him as he is,' face to face." (CCC 1023) Indeed, we will *see* God face to face (Ps. 17:15). We will live as God's children and partake of His life. We will truly be the apple of His eye (Ps. 17:8).

Should we be admitted into heaven, we will see His glory. And our joy will be full.

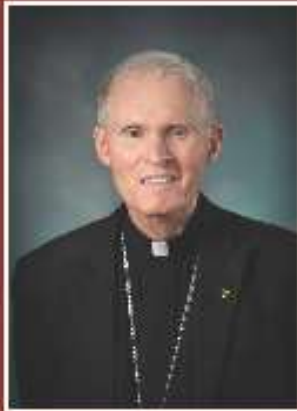



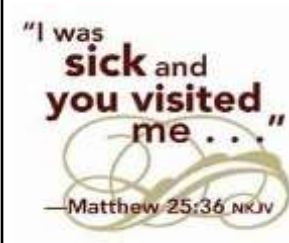
