 That the language of love and dialogue may always prevail over the language of conflict.

Protecting our young people, an open letter from the Office of Safe Environment.

Greetings from the Chancery,

Our Safe Environment program includes the completion of awareness training, background checks for employees and volunteers (including clergy), and a zero-tolerance policy for sex offenses as well as guidelines for working with and supervising children. This program was fully implemented in 2002; however as far back as the mid- to late-1990s, the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston was offering sex abuse awareness training for adults. In addition, starting in 2005, we implemented an awareness training program for our children in grades kindergarten through 12 to teach them safe touch, boundaries, and how to tell a trusted adult when something inappropriate has occurred.

Since 2015, the day-to-day operations of the Safe Environment program at the Chancery level have been carried out by a female lay person (me). In addition, there are approximately 150 local level coordinators (the overwhelming majority of whom are lay persons) throughout the Diocese working at the parish and school levels to ensure that the Safe Environment process is carried out.

Also, for many years, we have regularly convened a Sex Abuse Review Board comprised of lay members whose oversight entails ensuring that allegations are reported to the appropriate civil authorities and are handled to the appropriate conclusions, with emphasis placed on assistance for victims.

Instructions for reporting sex abuse to civil (and church) authorities can be found on the Diocese's web site, www.dwc.org and on posters throughout our parishes and schools, in weekly parish bulletins, and in the Catholic Spirit, which is sent free of charge to every registered Catholic household in the Diocese twice per month.

Looking forward as a result of recent circumstances, the Diocese is updating the Safe Environment section of the web site with more Safe Environment-related information and resources as well as a Frequently Asked Questions section as I type this. Also, our lay-led Review Board will be meeting with more frequency. In fact, they will be convening again as soon as next week.

We encourage any parishioners in the Diocese who have questions or concerns about our Safe Environment efforts to reach out to us. We always look forward to answering your questions and hope this information gives you some comfort that there are many good people working within the Diocese to help ensure the safety of children.

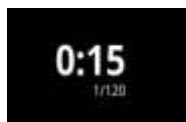
