James Sparks has decided to move in a new direction with his life and so will be resigning on February 10th from his position as our Music Director. Our prayers go with him.

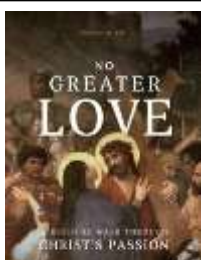

## Candlemas Meaning and Brief History

Candlemas, Christian festival on February 2 commemorating the occasion when the Virgin Mary, in obedience to Jewish law, went to the Temple in Jerusalem both to be purified 40 days after the birth of her son, Jesus, and to present him to God as her firstborn (Luke 2:22–38). The festival was formerly known in the Roman Catholic Church as the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is now known as the Presentation of the Lord. In the Anglican church it is called the Presentation of Christ in the Temple. In the Greek church it is called Hypapante (Meeting), in reference to Jesus’ meeting in the Temple with the aged Simeon and the prophet Anna.

The earliest reference to the festival is from Jerusalem, where in the late 4th century the Western pilgrim Etheria attended its celebration on February 14, 40 days after Epiphany (then celebrated as Christ’s birthday), and wrote of it in the Peregrinatio Etheriae. It soon spread to other Eastern cities, and in 542 Justinian I decreed that its date should be moved back to February 2 (40 days after Christmas). By the middle of the 5th century the custom of observing the festival with lighted candles had been introduced, and the name Candlemas developed from this custom. In the Western church, Pope Sergius I (687–701) instituted the festival in Rome. In the East it is primarily a festival of Christ. In the West it was primarily a celebration of the Virgin Mary until the calendar reform of 1969.

## West Virginia's Hope Scholarship

empowers families to make school choices that are right for their educational needs. The Hope Scholarship program offers qualifying West Virginia's K-12 students an opportunity to build an individual learning experience that works best for their child. The scholarship allows K-12 students to receive financial assistance that can be used for tuition, homeschool curriculum, and other qualifying expenses.

### Who can participate?

Currently enrolled students in the HOPE Scholarship program.

West Virginia students eligible to be enrolled in kindergarten for the 2024-25 school year.

West Virginia students enrolled full-time in a West Virginia public elementary or secondary school for the entire instructional term of the academic year preceding the academic year for which the student is applying to participate in the Hope Scholarship Program.

West Virginia students enrolled full-time and attending a West Virginia public elementary or secondary school for at least 45 consecutive calendar days during the current instructional term at the time of application for the Hope Scholarship Program. The student must remain enrolled and attending the public-school program until a decision is reached on the Hope Scholarship application.

### 2025-2026 School Year

Existing Hope Scholarship students wishing to continue participation in the program for the 2025-2026 year will be able to complete the continued participation confirmation process from January 3, 2025 to June 15, 2025.

Applications for new students will open on March 1, 2025. The Hope Scholarship Board will accept applications year-round, but the timing of submission of the original application for the program will determine the amount of the Hope Scholarship received for the student's initial year of participation in the program. The application windows for 2025-2026 and the corresponding funding amounts are outlined in the chart below:

Application Window Funding Amount

- \* Mar 1, 2025 – June 15, 2025 100% of Scholarship
- \* Jun 16, 2025 – Sept 15, 2025 75% of Scholarship
- \* Sept 16, 2025 – Nov 30, 2025 50% of Scholarship
- \* Dec 1, 2025 – Feb 28, 2026 25% of Scholarship
- \* After Feb 28, 2026 No funding for 2025-26 but can apply for 2026-27 year.

## PARENT INFORMATION REGARDING TUITION ASSISTANCE

### 2025-2026 DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE PROCESS OPENS FEBRUARY 1ST 2025.

For the 34th consecutive year, the Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) is striving to keep Catholic school education affordable for families who desire it for their children but who may need some financial assistance to make that dream a reality. Thanks to the ongoing and genuine commitment of Bishop Mark Brennan to the Catholic schools in our Diocese, funds have, once again, been allocated for distribution to families in need of financial assistance.

Applying for TAP through FACTS is easy and affordable. You are encouraged to apply if your child is already enrolled or has been accepted by one of the Catholic schools in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston for the 2025-2026 school year.

Who is eligible? Any student accepted for the 2025-2026 school year in any Diocesan Catholic school (PK thru grade 12) are eligible.

Determinations are based upon a family's degree of need relative to all other applicants.

Phase I: open to Catholic families ONLY

Phase II: open to ALL families

Phase III: open to ALL families-intended for families new to the school or have had a life-changing event.

How do I apply? Applications are made on-line. Go to [www.factsmgt.com](http://www.factsmgt.com), click on "Grant & Aid Assessment" and log in. If you do not have Internet access, contact your school office for assistance.

**Cost?** The application fee is now \$25.

**Grants:** Diocesan grants for families who have completed their applications and show financial need will receive up to 50% of the child's tuition.

**IMPORTANT-PLEASE READ-Phase I Deadline - April 30, 2025:** In order to receive notification in late May, applications (including all required documentation and payment) are to be received by FACTS by April 30, 2025.

**Phase I** is intended for Catholic families ONLY with children currently enrolled or already accepted for the 2025- 2026 school year in any Catholic school in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston. Families must belong to a parish included on the drop-down list as part of the on-line application.

**Phase II Deadline – July 14, 2025:** In order to receive notification in August, all applications for 2025-2026 (including all required documentation and payment) MUST be RECEIVED by FACTS no later than July 14, 2025.

**Phase II** is now intended for Catholic and Non-Catholic families. If an application was submitted during Phase I, please contact the school. Please do NOT submit a second application.

**Phase III Deadline – August 23, 2025:** In order to receive notification in August, all applications for 2025-2026 (including all required documentation and payment) MUST be RECEIVED by FACTS no later than August 23, 2025.

**Phase III** is now intended for Catholic and Non-Catholic families new to the school or who have had a life-changing event (i.e., birth, death, loss of job, major illness)

**Note 1:** No assistance will be available from the Diocese or from any school unless:

1. an application is completed in full (ALL questions answered) and submitted
2. all required documentation is provided, AND
3. the family portion (\$25.00) of the application fee is paid by the deadline.

**Note 2:** ONLY ONE APPLICATION PER FAMILY should be submitted per school year. If you made an error or had a life event change, please do NOT submit a second application. Contact your principal and your application can be updated by FACTS.


