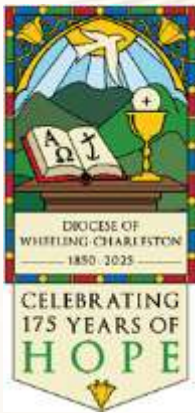
The Knights of Columbus #771

Archbishop Coakley Calls for Holy Hour as a Moment of Renewal for Our Hearts and Our Nation

"Let us pray for reconciliation where there is division, for justice where there are violations of fundamental rights, and for consolation for all who feel overwhelmed by fear or loss."

WASHINGTON – “Your faith matters. Your prayers matter. Your acts of love and works of justice matter,” said Archbishop Paul S. Coakley, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops. “The current climate of fear and polarization, which thrives when human dignity is disregarded, does not meet the standard set by Christ in the Gospel,” he continued, and as a step toward healing, invited bishops and priests across the United States to offer a Holy Hour for Peace.

Archbishop Coakley’s full reflection and invitation follow:

Many people today feel powerless in the face of violence, injustice, and social unrest. To those who feel this way, I wish to say clearly: your faithfulness matters. Your prayers matter. Your acts of love and works of justice matter.

I am deeply grateful for the countless ways Catholics and all people of good will continue to serve one another and work for peace and justice. Whether feeding the hungry, [welcoming the stranger](#), caring for the sick, accompanying the lonely, visiting the imprisoned, or striving daily to love their neighbors, no work of mercy or act of justice is ever wasted in the eyes of God. While proper laws must be respected, works of mercy, peacefully assembling, and caring for those in your community are signs of hope, and they build peace more surely than anger or despair ever could. Christ reminds us that even ‘a single cup of cold water’ given in his name will not go unrewarded (cf. Mt 10:42).

The recent killing of two people by immigration enforcement officers in Minneapolis and that of a detained man in Texas, are just a few of the tragic examples of the violence that represent failures in our society to respect the dignity of every human life. We mourn this loss of life and deplore the indifference and injustice it represents. The current climate of fear and polarization, which thrives when human dignity is disregarded, does not meet the standard set by Christ in the Gospel.

As a step toward healing, I invite my brother bishops and priests across the United States to offer a [Holy Hour for Peace](#) in the days ahead. Let us pray for reconciliation where there is division, for justice where there are violations of fundamental rights, and for consolation for all who feel overwhelmed by fear or loss. I encourage Catholics everywhere to participate, whether in parishes, chapels, or before the Lord present in the quiet of their hearts for healing in our nation and communities.

May this Holy Hour be a moment of renewal for our hearts and for our nation. Entrusting our fears and hopes to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, let us ask the Lord to make us instruments of his peace and witnesses to the inherent dignity of every person.

Let us pray together, confident that God hears the cry of his people and remains close to all who seek him.

Applications will be accepted beginning January 30, 2026 on the following schedule

February 6 - Open enrollment for Parishioners

February 13 – Open enrollment for General public

Sacred Heart Grade School applications for new students can be found on the school website at www.shgs.us. Select the “admissions tab” and then “apply now”. There is a \$25 application fee on the site and your application is not complete until fee is paid. Charleston Catholic new student applications can be completed through www.charlestoncatholicwv.org. Select the “Admission” tab to begin the application process.

Tuition Assistance is available through the Diocesan TAP program as well as the WV Hope Scholarship program. Students are eligible for both programs within the guidelines of each program.

New Hope Scholarship Applicants: Prepare NOW for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

Students who are newly eligible to apply for the Hope Scholarship in the 2026-2027 school year under the expanded eligibility rules are encouraged to act now to request a West Virginia Education Information System (WVEIS) ID number from their county board of education, if they don't already have one. The WVEIS ID# is a required field on the Hope Scholarship application. **All new applicants (including students entering kindergarten) must have their WVEIS ID# from the county board of education before they can successfully complete their Hope Scholarship application in the online portal when the 2026-2027 new application window opens on March 2, 2026.**

To request your child's WVEIS ID# from your local county board of education, please complete the new **WVEIS ID Request Form** and submit it by email to the county board of education of your county of residence using the county email address. Upon receipt of the form, county board of education will supply the number to you by email. Response time from the county board of education will depend on the volume of forms received.

If you already know your child's WVEIS ID# from their previous participation in public school, you do not need to complete the new request form to obtain one.

The Hope Scholarship program expects up to 20,000 new applicants for the upcoming 2026-2027 school year due to the expanded eligibility provisions. **Families are encouraged to complete the WVEIS ID# request form as soon as possible to obtain the number prior to the application window opening in March.** The earlier families request their child's WVEIS ID#, the more likely they will have it prior to the 100% funding deadline on June 15, 2026. Waiting until the last minute to request a WVEIS ID# may result in your student falling into a lesser funding bracket for the 2026-2027 school year.

Once you receive your student's WVEIS ID# from the county board of education, please retain it for your records so you are prepared to submit your student's Hope Scholarship application for the **2026-2027 school year when applications open on March 2, 2026**. Please do not attempt to apply for the Hope Scholarship as a new student in the online portal prior to March 2, 2026. If you misplace your student's WVEIS ID#, please reach out to the county board of education for assistance.

Also, please note that submission of this new form to obtain your student's WVEIS ID# will not replace the requirement to submit your student's Hope Scholarship Notice of Intent (NOI) to the county board of education **after** your student's Hope Scholarship application is found eligible. Please wait until the decision on your student's Hope Scholarship application next spring to submit a NOI to the county board of education for 2026-2027.

PARENT INFORMATION REGARDING TUITION ASSISTANCE

2026-2027 DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE PROCESS OPENS FEBRUARY 1, 2026.

For the 35th consecutive year, the Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) is striving to keep Catholic school education affordable for families who desire it for their children but who may need some financial assistance to make that dream a reality. Thanks to the ongoing and genuine commitment of Bishop Mark Brennan to the Catholic schools in our Diocese, funds have, once again, been allocated for distribution to families in need of financial assistance.

Applying for TAP through FACTS is easy and affordable. You are encouraged to apply if your child is already enrolled or has been accepted by one of the Catholic schools in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston for the 2026-2027 school year.

Who is eligible? Any student accepted for the 2026-2027 school year in any Diocesan Catholic school (Tiny Hearts thru grade 12) are eligible. Determinations are based upon a family's degree of need relative to all other applicants.

Phase I: open to Catholic families ONLY

Phase II: open to ALL families – Catholic families (not in Phase 1) & Non-Catholic families

Phase III: open to ALL families not in Phase 1 or 2

How do I apply? Applications are made on-line. Go to <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid> and log in. If you do not have Internet access, contact your school office for assistance.

Cost? The application fee per family is \$25.

Grants: Diocesan grants for families who have completed their applications and show financial need will receive up to 50% of the child's tuition.

IMPORTANT-PLEASE READ

Phase I Deadline In order to receive notification in late May, applications (*including all required documentation and April 30, 2026* are to be received by **FACTS by April 30, 2026** Phase I is intended for **Catholic families ONLY**. Families must belong to a parish included on the drop-down list as part of the on-line application.

Phase II Deadline In order to receive notification in August, all applications for 2026-2027 (*including all required July 14, 2026* **documentation and payment**) **MUST** be **RECEIVED** by FACTS no later than **July 14, 2026**. Phase II is intended for **Catholic (not in Phase 1) and Non-Catholic families**.

Phase III Deadline In order to receive notification in September, applications (*including all required documentation August 23, 2026* **and payment**) **MUST** be **RECEIVED** by FACTS no later than **August 23, 2026**. Phase III is intended for **Catholic and Non-Catholic families not in Phase 1 or 2**.

Note 1: No assistance will be available from the Diocese or from any school unless:

1. an application is completed in full (ALL questions answered) and submitted
2. all required documentation is provided, **AND**
3. the application fee is paid **by the deadline**.

Note 2: ONLY ONE APPLICATION PER FAMILY should be submitted per school year. If you made an error or had a life event change, please do NOT submit a second application. Contact your principal and your application can be updated by FACTS.
