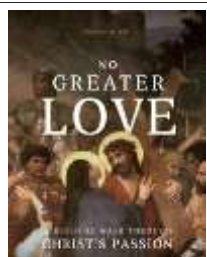

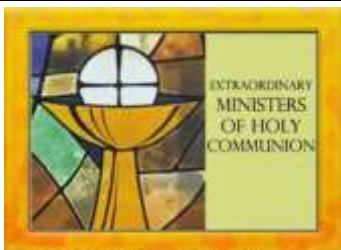

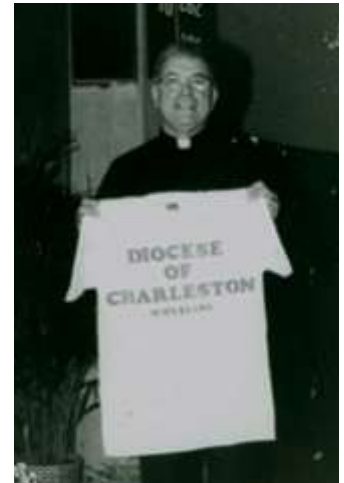

Father Sadie Educational Fund

For students at Sacred Heart Grade School and Charleston Catholic High School is currently financially supporting 6 students and will support them until their high school graduation. Father Sadie established this IRS tax exempt fund prior to his death with the goal of supporting a student in each class from preschool through 12th grade. Father Sadie was well known for his belief that Catholic education transforms a child's life. Financial assistance is provided to parish and non-parish children, children of immigrants and children of color. To support a child in each class the fund needs an endowed value of at least \$1 million. It currently is at \$789,000. West Virginia's Hope Scholarship

empowers families to make school choices that are right for their educational needs. The Hope Scholarship program offers qualifying West Virginia's K-12 students an opportunity to build an individual learning experience that works best for their child. The scholarship allows K-12 students to receive financial assistance that can be used for tuition, homeschool curriculum, and other qualifying expenses.

Who can participate?

Currently enrolled students in the HOPE Scholarship program.

West Virginia students eligible to be enrolled in kindergarten for the 2024-25 school year.

West Virginia students enrolled full-time in a West Virginia public elementary or secondary school for the entire instructional term of the academic year preceding the academic year for which the student is applying to participate in the Hope Scholarship Program.

West Virginia students enrolled full-time and attending a West Virginia public elementary or secondary school for at least 45 consecutive calendar days during the current instructional term at the time of application for the Hope Scholarship Program. The student must remain enrolled and attending the public-school program until a decision is reached on the Hope Scholarship application.

2025-2026 School Year

Existing Hope Scholarship students wishing to continue participation in the program for the 2025-2026 year will be able to complete the continued participation confirmation process from January 3, 2025 to June 15, 2025.

Applications for new students will open on March 1, 2025. The Hope Scholarship Board will accept applications year-round, but the timing of submission of the original application for the program will determine the amount of the Hope Scholarship received for the student's initial year of participation in the program. The application windows for 2025-2026 and the corresponding funding amounts are outlined in the chart below:

- | Application Window | Funding Amount |
|--------------------------------|--|
| * Mar 1, 2025 – June 15, 2025 | 100% of Scholarship |
| * Jun 16, 2025 – Sept 15, 2025 | 75% of Scholarship |
| * Sept 16, 2025 – Nov 30, 2025 | 50% of Scholarship |
| * Dec 1, 2025 – Feb 28, 2026 | 25% of Scholarship |
| * After Feb 28, 2026 | No funding for 2025-26 but can apply for 2026-27 year. |

PARENT INFORMATION REGARDING TUITION ASSISTANCE

2025-2026 DIOCESAN TUITION ASSISTANCE PROCESS OPENS FEBRUARY 1ST 2025.

For the 34th consecutive year, the Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) is striving to keep Catholic school education affordable for families who desire it for their children but who may need some financial assistance to make that dream a reality. Thanks to the ongoing and genuine commitment of Bishop Mark Brennan to the Catholic schools in our Diocese, funds have, once again, been allocated for distribution to families in need of financial assistance.

Applying for TAP through FACTS is easy and affordable. You are encouraged to apply if your child is already enrolled or has been accepted by one of the Catholic schools in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston for the 2025-2026 school year.

Who is eligible? Any student accepted for the 2025-2026 school year in any Diocesan Catholic school (PK thru grade 12) are eligible. Determinations are based upon a family's degree of need relative to all other applicants.

Phase I: open to Catholic families ONLY

Phase II: open to ALL families

Phase III: open to ALL families-intended for families new to the school or have had a life-changing event.

How do I apply? Applications are made on-line. Go to www.factsmgt.com, click on "Grant & Aid Assessment" and log in. If you do not have Internet access, contact your school office for assistance.

Cost? The application fee is now \$25.

Grants: Diocesan grants for families who have completed their applications and show financial need will receive up to 50% of the child's tuition.

IMPORTANT-PLEASE READ-Phase I Deadline - April 30, 2025: In order to receive notification in late May, applications (including all required documentation and payment) are to be received by FACTS by April 30, 2025.

Phase I is intended for Catholic families ONLY with children currently enrolled or already accepted for the 2025- 2026 school year in any Catholic school in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston. Families must belong to a parish included on the drop-down list as part of the on-line application.

Phase II Deadline – July 14, 2025: In order to receive notification in August, all applications for 2025-2026 (including all required documentation and payment) MUST be RECEIVED by FACTS no later than July 14, 2025.

Phase II is now intended for Catholic and Non-Catholic families. If an application was submitted during Phase I, please contact the school. Please do NOT submit a second application.

Phase III Deadline – August 23, 2025: In order to receive notification in August, all applications for 2025-2026 (including all required documentation and payment) MUST be RECEIVED by FACTS no later than August 23, 2025.

Phase III is now intended for Catholic and Non-Catholic families new to the school or who have had a life-changing event (i.e., birth, death, loss of job, major illness)

Note 1: No assistance will be available from the Diocese or from any school unless:

1. an application is completed in full (ALL questions answered) and submitted
2. all required documentation is provided, AND
3. the family portion (\$25.00) of the application fee is paid by the deadline.


