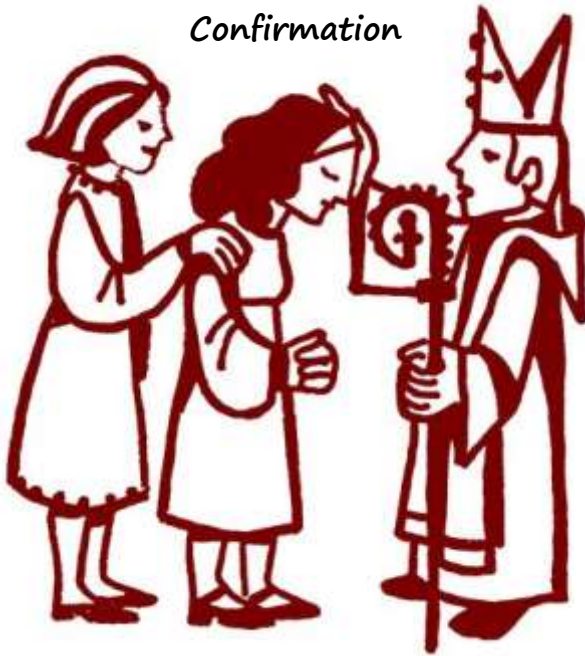

The Knights of Columbus is looking into obtaining a copy of the movie *Jesus Thirsts: The Miracle of the Eucharist* to show before a parish audience. Several of us saw this movie and feel it helped us with our historical understanding and appreciation for the Eucharist.

Knights of Columbus at Mass

At times, the faithful may see the Fourth Degree Color Corps of the Knights of Columbus in uniform and taking a ceremonial role during the Mass. Their presence can lend formality and solemnity to the occasion. Because each Knight strives to be a model of the Christian life, the group's presence and actions spring from a desire to act charitably and faithfully whether inside or outside the parish church. The Color Corps traditionally takes part in the entrance and recession of the Mass, as well as the consecration. For example, its members may take positions in the aisle to form an honor guard as the ministers process through the nave both at the entrance and the recession. If there is no room, the corps may occupy an alternate location, such as the head of the aisle. They normally take their positions ahead of the Processional Cross because they are not part of the procession of ministers; they are honoring it.

The corps may lift swords as the ministers go by. However, in some dioceses and parishes, local guidelines request that swords remain sheathed, especially if this symbol of respect could be misinterpreted as a glorification of weapons.

In some places, uniformed Knights then take seats near the front; in other places, they sit near the back.

During the consecration of the Mass, the corps members traditionally remove their hats and lift their swords, again as a sign of respect. However, in some places this is not practiced in hopes that the Knights would participate in the same way as the rest of the faithful. The gloves that form part of their uniform are to be removed for Communion, especially to accommodate those who usually receive Communion in the hand.


